Shawflex is committed to conducting business responsibly in accordance with environmental and social regulations. As a manufacturer, we ensure that our materials, processes, and supply chain align with international and national regulatory standards, including REACH, RoHS, Conflict Minerals, and Canadian PFAS regulations.

### **REACH Compliance (EC No. 1907/2006)**

There is a minimal fraction of Shawflex products that do not comply with the European Union Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH). These would be products that contain substances of very high concern (SVHCs) in concentrations above 0.1% by weight, as published in the latest official ECHA candidate list. We actively monitor updates to the SVHC list and maintain communication with our suppliers to ensure continued compliance.

### **RoHS Compliance (Directive 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU)**

Shawflex confirms that our wire and cable products are compliant with the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU, as amended by Directive 2015/863/EU. To our knowledge, our products do not exceed the allowable limits of the ten restricted substances, including Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI), Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB), and Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE), as well as four additional phthalates (DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP).

### **Conflict Minerals (Dodd-Frank Act Section 1502)**

In accordance with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, we are committed to ensuring that our products do not contain Conflict Minerals—namely Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, or Gold (3TG)—sourced from mines that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries. We require our suppliers to provide due diligence documentation and to source responsibly in accordance with our [Supplier Code of Conduct](#).

### **Canadian PFAS Regulations**

We recognize the increasing regulatory focus on per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in Canada, including recent measures by Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) aimed at restricting the manufacture, import, and use of PFAS-containing products.

Shawflex is actively evaluating PFAS presence across our product lines in collaboration with our suppliers. While PFAS are not intentionally used in the formulation of the vast majority of our products, a minimal fraction may contain PFAS-related substances due to the specialized nature of certain compound formulations.

We are working closely with our supply chain partners to identify and manage these instances, and we remain committed to meeting all applicable Canadian PFAS regulatory requirements. If product-specific PFAS information is required, we are happy to provide further details upon request.
